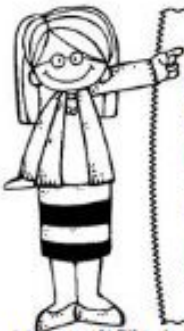


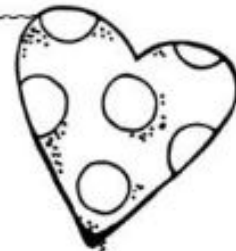
Hello First Grader
