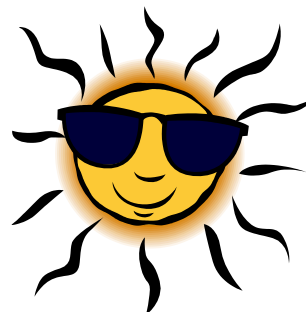
Dear New Fourth Grader,
